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APPROVED ASSEMBLIES

Tradename: Tri-Built Alum. Slant Back Vent 50/SQIN NFA

System Type A: Mechanical attachment of static vent over composite shingles.

Cutout: Vents shall be evenly centered. Center the vent hole between rafters. Vent shall be

installed a minimum 18" and a maximum 24" below the ridgeline measured to the closest point of the unit to the ridge. Mark this position. Using marked position as center point

scribe a 9 1/4" diameter circle. Starting with the drill hole cut vent hole.

Installation: Vents should be evenly spaced on the rear slope of the roof.

Remove roofing nails from top row of shingles so the flashing of the roof vent will slide under shingles. Apply approved roof cement around the edge of the hole. Carefully slide base of vent under shingles with non-louvered, slant back facing the peak of roof. Make

sure the throat of the vent is centered over vent hole.

Fasten the vent's base to roof decking with corrosion resistance annular ring shank nails located 1" from each corner and 1" from the edge at the midpoint between corners of the vent flange for a total of eight nails. (See Tri-Built Alum. Slant Back Vent 50/SQIN NFA profile drawings herein.) Nails shall be 0.125" shaft diameter, 0.349" diameter head, and $1\frac{1}{2}$ " shaft length and of sufficient length to penetrate through the sheathing a minimum

 $^{3}/_{16}$ ". Seal all seams and nail heads with an approved roofing sealant.

Ventilation Calculations: Refer to manufacturer's published literature.

Minimum Slope: 3:12

GENERAL LIMITATIONS:

1. Refer to applicable building codes for required ventilation.

- 2. Tri-Built Alum. Slant Back Vent 50/SQIN NFA shall be installed over composition shingles roofs only.
- 3. Tri-Built Alum. Slant Back Vent 50/SQIN NFA shall not be installed on roof mean heights greater than 33 feet.
- **4.** All products listed herein shall have a quality assurance audit in accordance with the Florida Building Code and Rule 61G20-3 of the Florida Administrative Code.
- 5. All approved products listed herein shall be labeled and shall bear the imprint or identifiable marking of the manufacturer's name or logo, city and state of manufacturing facility, and following statement: "Miami-Dade County Product Control Approved" or the Miami-Dade County Product Control Seal as shown below.







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DETAIL A

TRI-BUILT ALUM. SLANT BACK VENT 50/SQIN NFA


